

Aldershot Cold Storage R.I.P. A decades old landmark in the Burlington area has always been the Aldershot Cold Storage facility West of Waterdown road. Built in the 1930s for area farmers requiring refrigerated storage of fruit and vegetables, the end is now here as a crew from Triple M Demolition chews away at the reinforced concrete structure.
